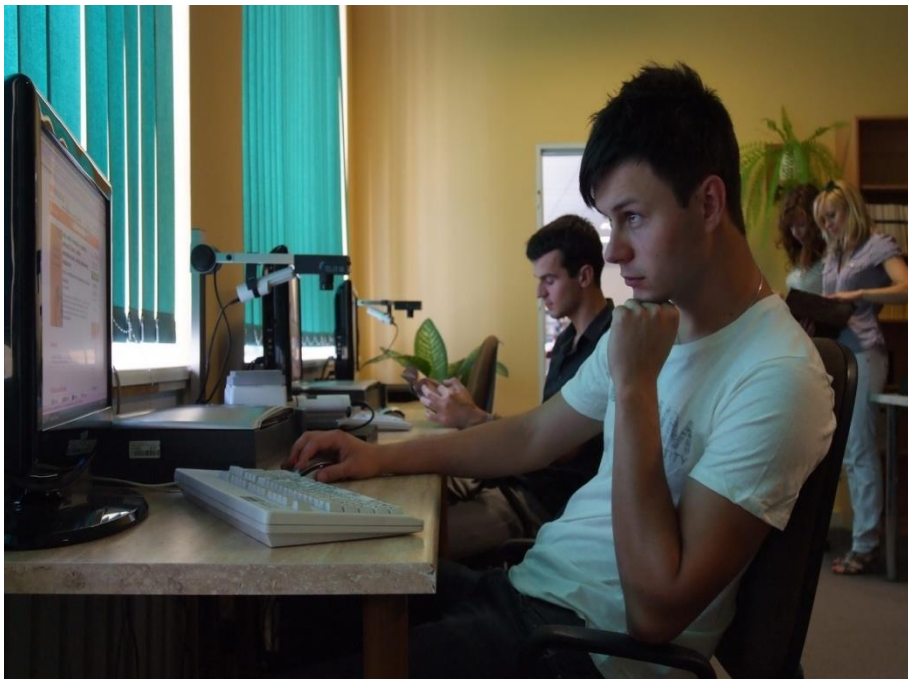

# UE FP 7 PROJECTS

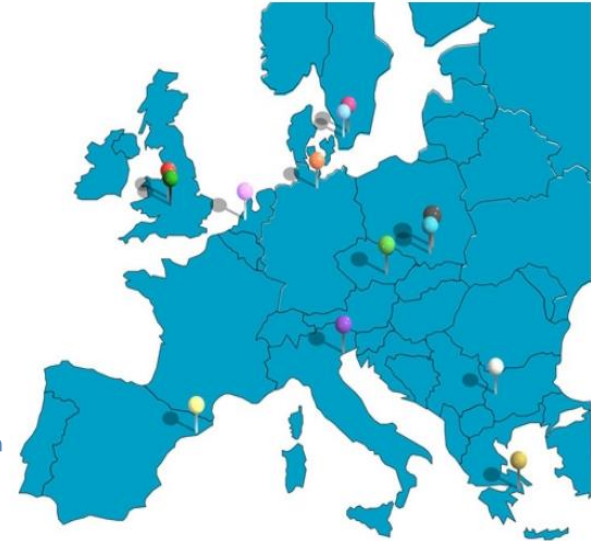
**CITISPYCE – combating inequalities through innovative social practices of, and for, young people in cities across Europe.**



CITISPYCE is a 3 year collaborative project, funded by the European Commission under the FP7 Research and Development programme for Social Sciences and Humanities (SSH).

The project was launched in January 2013 and is set against the back drop of widening social inequalities and renewed concerns about the disproportionate impact of the global economic crisis on young people.

The project is a collaborative venture coordinated by Aston University, UK and involving 12 other partners from 10 countries across the EU. These also include stakeholders from civil society, who are experienced in policy-making and delivery, as well as an interdisciplinary team of academic researchers from 7 leading universities.

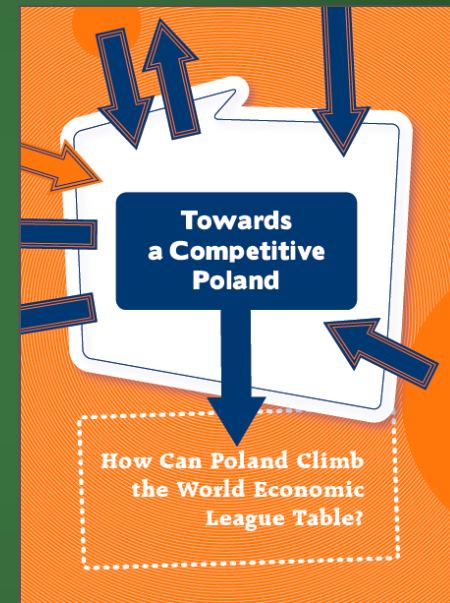

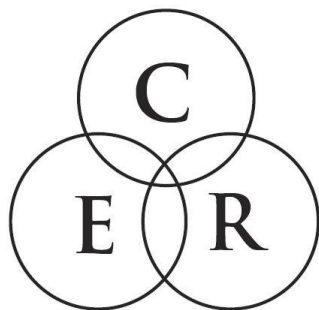

The collection was obtained in 2004 and at the same time the Joseph Retinger Centre for European Research was born.

- 4) cooperation with the centers of European thought and organizations at home and abroad having similar research strategies and objectives,**
- 5) cooperation with the Archives of the Polish Academy of Sciences and other similar entities,**
- 6) editorial activity,**
- 7) acquisition of European funds,**
- 8) development projects and training courses related to European issues.**
