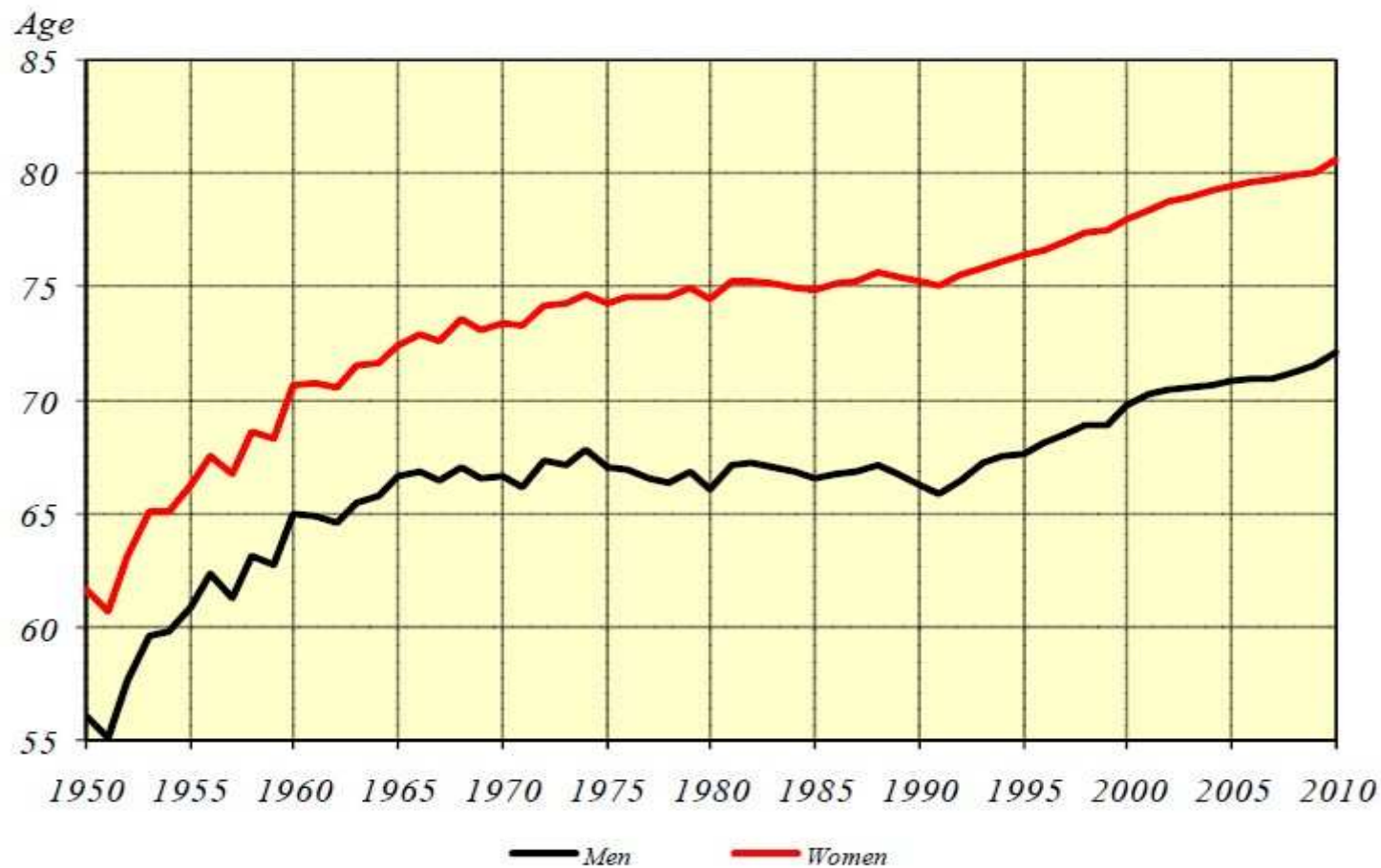

THE SURVEY ON UNEMPLOYED PERSONS WAS
CONDUCTED BY MEDICAL UNIVERSITY OF LODZ IN
2009 AND 2010

- The analysis revealed that the time of unemployment is linked with deterioration of mental health and quality of life.
- Improvement of quality of life and mental health can be achieved by: economic status improvement, strengthening of self esteem and ability to work, counteraction to social exclusion, physical activity increasment and preventing from the accumulation of unemployment in household.
