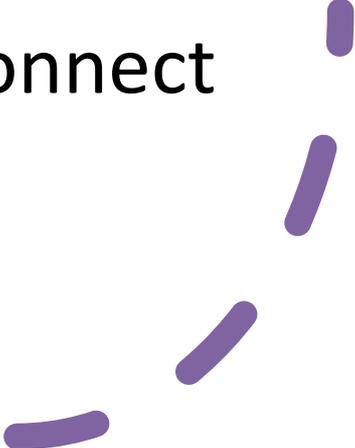
Czech Society: Four Attitudes

-  Active Greens (15–20%): Core environmental values, lifestyle changes
-  Light Greens (~50%): Care, but need external motivations
-  Indifferent (~30%): Unengaged with environmental issues
-  Dark Reds (~10%): Resistant to green narratives (growing group)
- Trend: Active Greens declining slightly, Dark Reds increasing

Schwartz's Value Theory

- Two key axes:
- - Openness to Change vs. Security
- - Self-Transcendence vs. Self-Enhancement
- Czech public leans toward: Security & Self-Enhancement
- Environmental action needs: Openness & Transcendence
- Challenge: Value mismatch in communication

The Christmas Tree Metaphor

- A tree with 4 levels of bulbs (body, emotion, thought, relationships)
 - Bulbs may shine, flicker, be off, or over-glow
 - They reflect life experiences and development
 - Education helps reconnect and regulate what is already within
- 



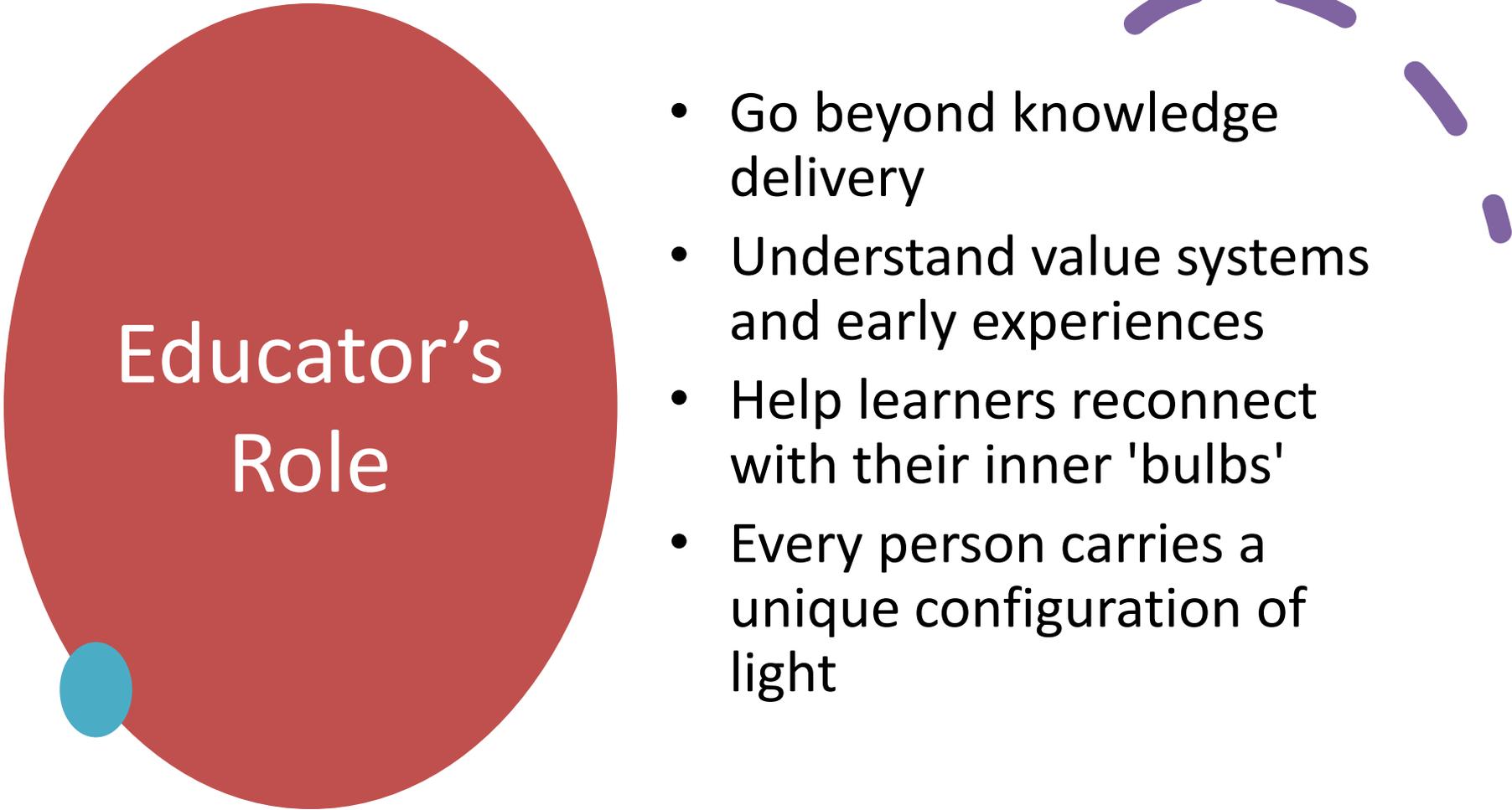
The Christmas Tree Metaphor

How Education Builds Resilience

- 1. Reflect working bulbs – validate strengths
 - 2. Provide nurturing environments (e.g. nature)
 - 3. Help reconnect dimmed or over-glowing bulbs
 - Rule: Only reflect what the person can see themselves
 - Trust is built through authenticity

Emotional and Cognitive Growth

- Body: Vertical vs. Horizontal energy (focused vs. flowing)
 - Emotions: Recognizing and working with hidden feelings
 - Thoughts: Helping ideas and cognitive lights shine again
 - Relationships: Crucial to all other development layers

Educator's Role

- Go beyond knowledge delivery
- Understand value systems and early experiences
- Help learners reconnect with their inner 'bulbs'
- Every person carries a unique configuration of light



Conclusion
